PRELIMINARY DRAFT - NOT READY FOR INTRODUCTION

GEN AN ACT ...; relating to: reduced fees for campsites in state campgrounds for state residents who have attained the age of 65.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the campsite fees for camping in state parks, state forests, and other properties under the management of the department of natural resources range from \$6 to \$\$ a night for gamping parties if the person making the reservation or registering for the campsite is a state resident. This bill reduces these campsite fees by 50% per night for camping parties where the person making the reservation 4 or registering for the campsite is a resident who is 65 years old or older.

For further information see the state fiscal estimate, which will be printed as

an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
