Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would address several personal privacy issues. There are two provisions in the bill that would affect the department of public instruction and local school districts: (1) the preparation of privacy impact statements; and (2) the adoption of written policies on who may enter and remain in a locker room.

1. Preparation of privacy impact statements. The bill would provide that whenever a bill is introduced in either house of the legislature that would have an impact upon personal privacy, any standing committee to which the bill is referred must not hold a public hearing on the bill or report the bill until a privacy impact statement is prepared and received. The statement would be prepared by one or more state agencies or authorities, as determined by the department of administration.

This provision would have no fiscal effect on the department. It is assumed that any additional costs associated with preparing privacy impact statements would be absorbed within the agency's operating budget.

This provision would have no local fiscal effect.

2. Locker room policies. The bill also would require each school board, private school, technical college district board, institution and two-year collegiate campus of the University of Wisconsin System, private institution of higher education, and professional athletic team that has its home field or arena in this state to adopt a written policy on who may enter and remain in a locker room used by the school or team to interview or seek information from any person.

This provision would have no state fiscal effect.

It is assumed that these policies could be developed by school districts through their regular administrative activities. Therefore, it is estimated that this bill would have no local fiscal effect.
