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


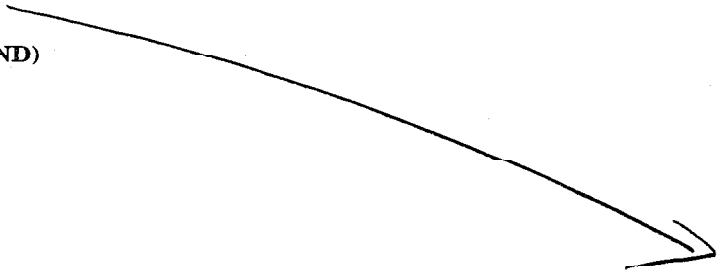
Under this bill, on July 1, 2004, 10% of the amount of the sales tax and use tax paid on the sale or use of motor vehicles and motor vehicle parts in the immediately preceding calendar year is transferred to the transportation fund. On each July 1 thereafter, the amount of such taxes to be transferred to the transportation fund is increased by 10% until on July 1, 2013, and on each July 1 thereafter, 100% of such taxes are transferred to the transportation fund.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

SUBJECT: Technical Memorandum on LRB 3499/1 Relating to the Transfer of Sales Tax on Automotive Products to the Transportation Fund

We have the following technical concerns with the bill:

1. The terms "motor vehicle" and "motor vehicle parts" are not defined.
2. An instruction is needed to allocate sales tax to the Transportation Fund and the General Fund when a vendor that has sales tax liability for both motor vehicle and taxable non-motor vehicle products pays only part of the total tax due.
3. The proposed legislation makes no provision for the funding of the costs involved in administering the activities required. If the author wishes to provide funding, appropriation language could be developed and costs allocated in the following manner:
