Hi Kathy,

I'll be working with Joe on this amendment, since I drafted (possibly) pertinent provisions of the budget bill. I may need clarification on this amendment request.

In Act 16 (the budget bill), changes were made to language in the DOT appropriations statutes. There is an existing appropriation of state funds for highway rehabilitation projects (s. 20.395 (3) (cq)) and for highway maintenance activities (s. 20.395 (3) (eq)). The budget bill included language in s. 20.395 (3) (cq) that prevented rehabilitation funds from being used for certain maintenance activities and, in connection with this new restriction, transferred \$27 million in fiscal year 2001-02 from the rehabilitation appropriation to the maintenance appropriation. The effect was to leave the highway rehabilitation appropriation at \$229 million in fiscal year 01-02 and \$273 million in fiscal year 02-03, and to leave the highway maintenance appropriation at \$189 million in fiscal year 01-02 and \$161 million in fiscal year 02-03. The budget bill also allows DOT to request that an additional \$10 million be transferred from the rehabilitation appropriation to the maintenance appropriation in fiscal year 02-03.

It was unclear to me whether you wanted to change something related to the \$27 million in the budget bill, or whether you simply wanted to specify that, of the sales and use tax receipts transferred to the transportation fund each year starting in 2004, at least \$27 million must be deposited into the highway maintenance appropriation (s. 20.395 (3) (eq))? Thanks for your help. Aaron
