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

1 AN ACT to create 16.38 of the statutes; relating to: review of state agency
2 performance and operations.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires that the ~~secretary of administration~~ establish a program, to be known as "Renew Wisconsin." Under the program, the ~~secretary~~ will appoint a committee for each state agency to conduct periodic performance evaluations of the operations of each state agency in the executive branch. In appointing members to the various committees, the ~~secretary~~ must seek to appoint to each committee both state and local government public officials and employees and individuals who are not state and local government public officials and employees.

Under the program, the committees must review the performance of the state agencies and must identify ways in which the state agencies can improve their responsiveness to the residents of this state and ways in which the state agencies can reduce the costs of performing their duties. In addition, under the program, the committees must review the statutes and rules that affect the operation of the state agencies and must specifically identify the statutes and rules that are obsolete and the statutes and rules that provide benefits that exceed their costs and those that provide benefits that do not exceed their costs. Finally, the committees must make recommendations for modifications to the statutes and rules to more effectively and efficiently accomplish the public policy goals contained in the statutes and rules.

Under the program, the committees must conduct public hearings, the department of administration must provide staff support for the operations of the committees, and all state agencies must fully cooperate with the committees.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. ~~16.38~~ of the statutes is created to read:

2 ~~16.38~~ **Renew Wisconsin.** (1) In this section:

3 (a) "Committee" means a committee appointed under sub. (2).

4 (b) "State agency" means an office, department, independent agency,
5 institution of higher education, association, society, or other body in the executive
6 branch of state government created or authorized to be created by the constitution
7 or any law and that is entitled to expend moneys appropriated by law, but not
8 including an authority created in ch. 231, 233, or 234.

9 (2) The ~~secretary~~^{governor} shall establish a program, entitled "Renew Wisconsin," under
10 which the ~~secretary~~^{governor} will appoint a committee for each state agency to conduct
11 periodic performance evaluations of the operations of each state agency. In
12 appointing members to the various committees, the ~~secretary~~^{governor} shall seek to appoint
13 to each committee both state and local government public officials and employees
14 and individuals who are not state and local government public officials and
15 employees.

16 (3) Each committee shall review the performance of the state agency assigned
17 to the committee and shall identify ways in which the state agency can improve its
18 responsiveness to the residents of this state and ways in which the state agency can
19 reduce the costs of performing its duties.

1 (4) Each committee shall review the statutes and rules that affect the operation
2 of the state agency assigned to the committee for review and shall do all of the
3 following:

4 (a) Identify the statutes and rules that are obsolete.

5 (b) Identify the statutes and rules that provide benefits that exceed their costs
6 and the statutes and rules that provide benefits that do not exceed their costs.

7 (c) Make recommendations for modifications to the statutes and rules to more
8 effectively and efficiently accomplish the public policy goals contained in the statutes
9 and rules.

10 (5) Each committee shall conduct one or more public hearings for the purpose
11 of gathering information to perform its duties under subs. (3) and (4).

12 (6) The department shall provide all staff support required for the operation
13 of each committee. *of administration*

14 (7) Each state agency shall fully cooperate with each committee and shall
15 provide any information requested by a committee.

16 (8) Each committee shall submit a written report of its findings, conclusions,
17 and recommendations to the governor and the chief clerk of each house of the
18 legislature, for distribution to the legislature under s. 13.172 (2).
