Under this bill, a student at a high school, University of Wisconsin System school, in-state technical college, or in-state, private, accredited, nonprofit college or university is eligible for a \$25[✓] tuition voucher if he or she plays the song "Taps" at a military honors funeral for a deceased veteran. The voucher is valid for four years and may only be used to pay tuition and program activity fees at a University of Wisconsin System school, in-state technical college, or in-state, private, accredited, nonprofit college or university. ✓

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under this bill, a student at a high school, University of Wisconsin System school, in-state technical college, or in-state, private, accredited, nonprofit college or university is eligible for a \$25 tuition voucher if he or she plays the song, "Taps" at a military honors funeral for a deceased veteran. The voucher is valid for four years and may only be used to pay tuition and program activity fees at a University of Wisconsin System school, in-state technical college, or in-state, private, accredited, nonprofit college or university. The department of veterans affairs will administer the tuition voucher program.
