Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under the bill, Chapter 45 language is created that authorizes a funeral director to issue a tuition voucher to an eligible student who plays taps on a bugle, trumpet or coronet during a military honors funeral for a deceased veteran. The bill specifically excludes the payment of such vouchors from the Military Funeral Honor Funeral Grant Program under 20.485(2)(q). As a result, the bill has no fiscal impact on the Department of Veterans Affairs.
