Subject: **Drafting Request for Amendment on AB504**

Could you please draft an amendment on AB-504 for Representative Hundertmark that allows a diploma for a veteran to be granted either by:

the school board of the school district where the person is a resident; or

(2) the school board of the school district where the person attended high school.

I was thinking of a substitute amendment that amended s. 120.13 (37), Stats., as follows:

(37) Awarding high school diplomas to veterans. Notwithstanding s. 118.33 (1), award a high school diploma to a person who attended high school in the school district or resides in the school district and attended high school in a school district in this state and is at least 65 years old, attended high school in the school district, left high school before receiving a high school diploma to join the U.S. armed forces during a war period under s. 45.35 (5) (e), and served on active duty under honorable conditions in the U.S. armed forces or in forces incorporated as part of the U.S. armed forces. A school board may award a high school diploma to a person who received a high school equivalency diploma under s. 115.29 (4) after serving on active duty if the person meets the other conditions of this paragraph.

In addition to the goal of giving a living veteran a choice of the two school districts from which to request a diploma (that is, it is two if the person doesn't live in the same school district as where he or she attended high school), another goal of the amendment would be not to have AB-504 nullify Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 (LRBs0123/1) to 2001 Senate Bill 61. ASA 1 to SB61 provides for high school diplomas to be awarded to deceased veterans if the conditions in what is currently 120.12 (37) are met, other than age. Since a deceased person doesn't "reside" in a school district, unless AB-504 is amended, it would essentially nullify ASA1 to SB-61.

Could you please send me a copy of the draft at the same time you send it to Rep. Hundertmark. Let me know if you have questions. Thanks for your help.

SECTION 1. 120.13 (37) of the statutes is renumbered 120.13 (37) (a) (intro.) and
amended to read:
120.13 (37) (a) (intro.) Notwithstanding s. 118.33 (1), award a high school
diploma to a person who meets all of the following requirements: is
1. Is at least 65 years old, attended.
2. Attended high school in the school district or attended high school in this
state and resides in the school district left.
3. Left high school before receiving a high school diploma to join the U.S. armed
forces during a war period under s. 45.35 (5) (e) and served.
4. Served on active duty under honorable conditions in the U.S. armed forces
or in forces incorporated as part of the U.S. armed forces.
