***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill requires that, upon the request of the department of natural resources (DNR), the department of justice (DOJ) conduct a background check for any person who is issued a license that authorizes hunting with a firearm (hunting license). If the search shows that the person is prohibited from possessing a firearm under state law, the bill requires that DNR revoke all of the person's current hunting licenses and deny the person any additional hunting licenses. The grounds under state law for prohibiting the possession of firearms include felony convictions and domestic or child abuse or harassment restraining orders and injunctions. The bill prohibits DOJ from collecting fees from DNR for these background checks.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

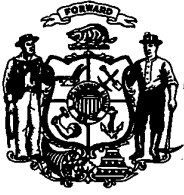

RE: AB 517. (hunting restrictions for felons)

We are writing to inform you of several changes to AB 517 that are being drafted in a substitute amendment. While we do not yet have a copy of the sub in hand, we hope the following changes address the concerns aired in the public hearing.

AB 517 now does the following:

1. Prohibits felons from purchasing any hunting license that authorizes the use of a firearm, except for a Class A Bear license or a wild turkey hunting license because there is no alternative license to allow the hunting of those species by bow and arrow.
2. Specifies that the Department of Natural Resources may request the Department of Justice to conduct a firearms-restrictions record search with respect to any person who has purchased a hunting license.
3. If the search reveals that a felon has obtained a license in violation of the above-mentioned restriction, the DNR may revoke any hunting license issued to that person.
4. Also, if a felon who is issued a Class A Bear license or a wild turkey hunting license is found to be hunting with a firearm, the DNR may revoke any hunting license issued to that person.
5. A person who violates these provisions is subject to a forfeiture of not more than \$200, and the court shall order the revocation of any current hunting privileges not already revoked by the DNR may prohibit the issuance of any such licenses to that person for three years. Violators must also pay all expenses related to the background check.
6. Finally, DOJ must work with the DNR to enable the latter department to access information from a criminal history search.

However, to avoid confusion, you may want to change the term used in this draft to some other type of search such as "felony record search".

Since the draft now authorizes courts to order reimbursement from violators for search fees, note the change made in s. 29.024 (1m) (e).

4 justice conduct a ~~firearms-restrictions~~ <sup>felony</sup> record search with respect to any person who  
5 is issued a firearms hunting license.

6 (d) The department of natural resources may request that the department of  
7 justice conduct a ~~firearms-restrictions~~ <sup>felony</sup> record search with respect to any person who  
8 is issued a Class A bear license or a wild turkey hunting license if the department  
9 of natural resources determines that the person has hunted with a firearm under the  
10 authority of either of these licenses.

11 (e) The department of justice may not charge the department of natural  
12 resources fees for ~~firearms-restrictions~~ <sup>felony</sup> record searches conducted under par. (c) or  
13 (d).

14 (f) A person who violates par. (b) shall forfeit not more than \$200, and the court
