Require DOS to collect mother's maiden name or other personal identifying information (that is generally not in criminal record) to firearm purchaser check.

This will allow DOS to determine if firearm purchaser is a different person from person w/ same name & DOB that has a criminal record. Currently DOS only collects name, DOB & address.

6 her name, date of birth, gender, race and, mother's maiden name, social security

9 (c) 4. The department of justice shall make the forms available at locations
10 throughout the state."
