

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 5,
TO 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 555**

October 16, 2001 – Offered by Representative VRAKAS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 15: delete lines 15 and 16 and substitute “occupation, if for
3 taxable years beginning after December 31, 2001, and ending before January 1,
4 2003, the apprenticeship program provides instruction related to any of the 3
5 manufacturing trades; any of the 3 construction trades; or any of the 3 private sector
6 service occupations; with the most projected job openings for new entrants, as
7 determined by the department, and if for taxable years beginning after December 31,
8 2002, the apprenticeship program provides instruction related to any of the 4
9 manufacturing trades; any of the 4 construction trades; or any of the 4 private”.

10 **2.** Page 5, line 14: delete lines 14 and 15 and substitute “occupation, if for
11 taxable years beginning after December 31, 2001, and ending before January 1,
12 2003, the apprenticeship program provides instruction related to any of the 3
13 manufacturing trades; any of the 3 construction trades; or any of the 3 private sector

1 service occupations; with the most projected job openings for new entrants, as
2 determined by the department, and if for taxable years beginning after December 31,
3 2002, the apprenticeship program provides instruction related to any of the 4
4 manufacturing trades; any of the 4 construction trades; or any of the 4 private”.

5 **3.** Page 7, line 25: delete that line.

6 **4.** Page 8, line 1: delete that line and substitute “occupation, if for taxable
7 years beginning after December 31, 2001, and ending before January 1, 2003, the
8 apprenticeship program provides instruction related to any of the 3 manufacturing
9 trades; any of the 3 construction trades; or any of the 3 private sector service
10 occupations; with the most projected job openings for new entrants, as determined
11 by the department, and if for taxable years beginning after December 31, 2002, the
12 apprenticeship program provides instruction related to any of the 4 manufacturing
13 trades; any of the 4 construction trades; or any of the 4 private”.
