

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Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, if DOC does require a person to pay the charge, the charge may not be less than \$2.50. This bill raises that minimum charge to \$4.00.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 302.386 (3) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

302.386 (3) (b) If the resident under par. (a) requests the medical services or dental services, the department shall require the resident to pay the deductible, coinsurance, copayment or similar charge. The department may not charge the person less than \$2.50 \$400 for each request. The requirements under this paragraph are subject to the exception and waiver provisions under par. (c).

ADULT CORRECTIONAL SYSTEM

Under current law (DOC) may require a prisoner in a secured correctional facility for adults or for children to pay a deductible, coinsurance, copayment, or similar charge if the prisoner receives medical or dental care and the prisoner tages while be are the interior resident of the sound pareties in the Currently,

DOC has the authority to exempt or waive the payment of those charges under criteria that DOC establishes by rule.

This bill deletes the requirement that the prisoner earn wages while he or she is a resident of the secured correctional facility before he or she may be required to pay a deductible, coinsurance, copayment, or similar charge.
