The actual and necessary expenses 5 of legislative policy research personnel, assistants to legislators, and research staff 6 assigned to legislative committees and party caucuses incident to attending 7 meetings outside the capital shall be reimbursed from the appropriation under s. 8 20.765 (1) (a) or (b). 9 **SECTION 2.** 13.20 (1) of the statutes is amended to read: 10 13.20 (1) NUMBER AND PAY RANGE OF LEGISLATIVE EMPLOYEES. The legislature or 11 either house thereof may employ under the unclassified service such policy research 2001 – 2002 Legislature – 2 –

1	noncoursel assistants to legislatons, and reasonable staff assigned to legislation
1	personnel, assistants to legislators, <u>and</u> research staff assigned to legislative
2	committees and party caucuses and such clerical, professional, or other assistants
3	as in the judgment of the joint committee on legislative organization or the
4	committee on organization in each house are necessary to enable it to perform its
5	functions and duties and to best serve the people of this state, except that the
6	<u>legislature or a house thereof may not employ a person for, or assign a person to, a</u>
7	<u>party caucus</u> .

18	(1) (a) The authorized FTE positions for the assembly, funded from the
19	appropriation under section 20.765 (1) (a) of the statutes, are decreased on January
20	1, 2002, by the number equal to the number of FTE positions assigned to the
21	assembly party caucuses on September 1, 2001, minus 3.0, to eliminate staffing of
22	party caucuses in the assembly.
23	(b) The authorized FTE positions for the senate, funded from the appropriation
24	under section 20.765 (1) (b) of the statutes, are decreased on January 1, 2002, by the

25 number equal to the number of FTE positions assigned to the senate party caucuses

1	on September 1, 2001, minus 3.0, to eliminate staffing of party caucuses in the
2	senate.
