I did not limit the benefit to this state because I thought that, given the nature of the business, a benefit to operations in one state may at least indirectly benefit business operations in another state. It may be impossible to use the proceeds in such a way that there is a benefit to only one location of operations. However, if you wish, I can redraft the amendment by adding "exclusively," "primarily," or "exclusively or primarily" after "par. (a)."
