anthem in grades one to 12 each school day. Every private school shall offer the pledge of allegiance or the national anthem in grades one to 12 each school day unless the governing body of the private school determines that the requirement conflicts with the school's religious doctrines. If a school offers the national anthem, it shall offer, at a minimum, both the music and the words to the first verse. No pupil may

- 1 be compelled, against the pupil's objections or those of the pupil's parents or
- 2 guardian, to recite the pledge or to sing the anthem.
