Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law limits the increase in the total amount of revenue that a school district may receive from general school aids and property taxes to approximately \$~~300~~ per pupil in the ~~2000-01~~ school year and, in subsequent school years, to the amount of revenue increase allowed per pupil in the previous school year increased by the percentage change in the consumer price index. Several exceptions exist. For example, if a school district increases the services that it provides by adding responsibility for providing a service transferred to it from another governmental unit, its revenue limit is increased by the cost of that service.

This bill increases a school district's revenue limit in any school year by the amount spent by the school district in the previous school year for participation of pupils in statewide tournaments and competitions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

ASSEMBLY BILL 285

SECTION 1

1 **SECTION 1.** 121.91 (4) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

2 121.91 (4) (b) The limit otherwise applicable to a school district's revenue under
3 sub. (2m) in any school year is increased by an amount equal to the amount spent by
4 the school district in the previous school year for participation of pupils in statewide
5 tournaments and competitions.

6 **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**

7 (1) This act first applies to the calculation of a school district's revenue limit
8 for the school year beginning after the effective date of this subsection.
