1 AN ACT ...; relating to: issuance of an identification card. ✓

**Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau**

Under current law, a person may apply for an identification card if he or she is a resident of the state and if he or she does not possess a valid motor vehicle operator's license that contains the person's photograph. The fee for the identification card is \$9 and the card is valid for ~~4~~<sup>four</sup> years from the person's next birthday after the date the card is issued. Under current law, an operator's license is valid for 8 years after the date of issuance, with limited exceptions.

This bill allows a person to apply for an identification card even if he or she possesses a valid motor vehicle operator's license that contains his or her photograph. Under the bill, the fee for an identification card is \$18 and the card is valid for ~~8~~<sup>eight</sup> years from the person's next birthday after the date the card is issued.

**The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:**

2 SECTION 1. 343.50 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

3 343.50 (2) WHO MAY APPLY. Any resident of this state who does not possess a  
4 valid operator's license which contains the resident's photograph issued under this

1 chapter may apply to the department for an identification card pursuant to this  
2 section. The card is not a license for purposes of this chapter and is to be used for

4 **SECTION 2.** 343.50 (5) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 343.50 (5) VALID PERIOD; FEES. The fee for an original card and for the  
6 reinstatement of an identification card after cancellation under sub. (10) shall be \$9  
7 \$18. The card shall be valid for the succeeding period of ~~4~~8 years from the applicant's  
8 next birthday after the date of issuance.
