Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prescribes the exact wording for questions located on a notification form prescribed by the department of justice in order to conduct background checks for firearm purchasers.

Currently the department has the ability to adjust the questions on the handgun hotline forms as necessary. If federal or state law changes, the department can quickly change the form to reflect this update. The questions prescribed in AB 603, although very similar to the ones the department currently has in use, might be out of date by legislative or federal action and therefore may cause an unnecessary lag if the department were to await legislative action to reflect new laws, most notably at the federal level.

In addition, one of the questions prescribed in AB 603, does not mirror the current federal forms and would therefore cause difficulties in prosecution.

The cost for each form change is approximately \$600.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
