Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This substitute amendment to Assembly Bill 621 addresses several personal privacy issues. One area that affects local school districts is the adoption of written policies on who may enter and remain in a locker room. The proposal requires each school board, private school, technical college district board, institution and two-year collegiate campus of the University of Wisconsin System, private institution of higher education, and professional athletic team that has its home field or arena in this state to adopt a written policy on who may enter and remain in a locker room used by the school or team to interview or seek information from any person.

It is assumed that these policies can be developed by the school district through regular administrative activities. Therefore this provision would have no local fiscal effect.
