Mark,

Sorry, it took me two days to get you this information. I intended on sending it Wednesday, but technology is fickle. Anyway, Rep. Schooff would like three pieces of legislation drafted. I have provided information on the first two, and will send the info on the last one at a later date. Hopefully the first two can be done pretty quickly, because they have already been drafted in different forms.

1. Require the DOA to investigate the use of Distributed Generation facilities in all of it's building projects over \$5 million.

This was included in the conference committee and was vetoed out by the Governor. I have included the language from Act 16 for you to use when drafting this.

2. Direct the DNR to establish a general permit for "Air Pollution Control Construction Permits", specifically for the use of distributed generation units.

The definition of distributed generation units, for this motion, is any form of energy generation used by electric consumers for power generation (such as photovoltaic cells, wind power, fuel cells, micro turbines, and natural gas internal combustion engines).

The Governor had a part of his budget that talked about pre-permitting for all types of machines, which I've included here. This is the idea, but we want to define it more narrowly so as only to apply it to Distributed Generation.

INS ANAL

This bill directs the department of administration (DOA) to investigate the potential to incorporate and to use distributed generation units in each state building project that is expected to involve an expenditure of \$5,000,000 or more. In conducting its investigation, the bill directs DOA to consider the cost effectiveness of such use, the potential for such use to increase statewide power generation capacity, and the potential for cost savings to be realized by the state from such use. Under the bill, DOA must report the results of its investigation, together with its recommendations and the reasons therefor, to the building commission prior to consideration of the project by the commission. The bill defines "distributed generation unit" to mean any form of energy generation that may be used by electric consumers for the generation of electric power.
