Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

There are approximately 10-15 projects annually over \$5 million that would meet this bill's threshold for considering the cost effectiveness of distributed generation units. The cost to conduct the investigation of distributed generation is estimated to range from \$2,500 in personnel costs if done by state staff or \$4,000 to \$5,000 if done by outside consultants.

If done by state staff other work managing or supervising projects would not be done. If done by outside consultants it would be part of the project cost for desing fees and very slighlty reduce funds available for construction.
