Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Bill Summary: This bill would provide to the City of Appleton \$250,000 of one-time funding. The funding would be used to reconstruct the Atlas Mill building so that it may be used to house a forestry education center. The center would be called the World Paper Center.

Fiscal Estimate: The bill would authorize the DNR to provide \$250,000 from the new 20.370(5)(ax) appropriation to the City of Appleton. The appropriation 20.370(5)(ax) would be funded from the Forestry Account of the Conservation Fund. The \$250,000 represents a one-time revenue to the City of Appleton. There would be no ongoing costs to the Department of Natural Resources, and an insignificant one time cost, to implement the bill.

The City of Appleton may have costs associated with the reconstruction project, but these costs are unknown at this time.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

If the reconstruction costs exceed the \$250,000, additional Forestry Account funding might be appropriated in the future. Presently the bill provides funding for one fiscal year.
