	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
3	SECTION 1. 23.0917 (4) (cm) 4. of the statutes is created to read:
4	23.0917 (4) (cm) 4. Reconstruction of the facility known as the Atlas Mill
5	located in the city of Appleton under s. 23.197 (5m).
6	SECTION 2. 23.197 (5m) of the statutes is created to read:
7	23.197 (5m) ATLAS MILL RECONSTRUCTION. From the appropriation under s.
8	20.866 (2) (ta), the department shall provide \$250,000 to an organization known as
9	the Paper International Hall of Fame, Inc., to reconstruct the facility known as the
10	Atlas Mill, located in the city of Appleton, into a facility containing a hands–on
11	forestry project designed principally to educate children about the relationship
12	between forestry and education. The facility shall be known as the "World Paper

Center." For the purposes of s. 23.0917, moneys provided under this subsection from
the appropriation under s. 20.866 (2) (ta) shall be treated as moneys obligated under
the subprogram for property development and local assistance.
