

**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 644**

January 24, 2002 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON RURAL AFFAIRS AND FORESTRY.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 23.0917 (4) (cm) 4. and 23.197 (5m) of the statutes; **relating**
2 **to:** funding for the reconstruction of the Atlas Mill in the city of Appleton.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 23.0917 (4) (cm) 4. of the statutes is created to read:

4 23.0917 **(4)** (cm) 4. Reconstruction of the facility known as the Atlas Mill
5 located in the city of Appleton under s. 23.197 (5m).

6 **SECTION 2.** 23.197 (5m) of the statutes is created to read:

7 23.197 **(5m)** ATLAS MILL RECONSTRUCTION. From the appropriation under s.
8 20.866 (2) (ta), the department shall provide \$250,000 to an organization known as
9 the Paper International Hall of Fame, Inc., to reconstruct the facility known as the
10 Atlas Mill, located in the city of Appleton, into a facility containing a hands-on
11 forestry project designed principally to educate children about the relationship
12 between forestry and education. The facility shall be known as the “World Paper

1 Center.” For the purposes of s. 23.0917, moneys provided under this subsection from
2 the appropriation under s. 20.866 (2) (ta) shall be treated as moneys obligated under
3 the subprogram for property development and local assistance.
