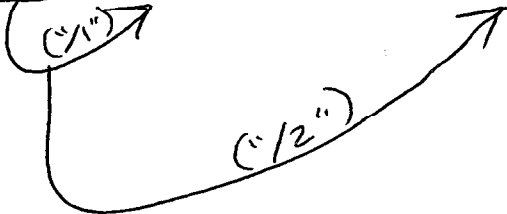

**PROPOSED BILL LRB4571/1 RELATING TO SUPPRESSING STREET
ADDRESS OF A FAMILY DAY CARE CENTERS OPERATING IN THE
PROVIDER'S HOME**

Drafting Instructions

Background

Under current law, the Department of Health and Family Services (DHFS) may license a person to operate a day care center or a county Department of Human Services or Department of Social Services. ~~An agency with which the county contracts~~ may certify a child care provider for reimbursement under the Wisconsin Shares child care subsidy program and a school board may contract for the provision of day care programs for children. In addition, as part of the child care prelicensing process, DHFS contracts with the Wisconsin Child Care Improvement Project (WCCIP), a non-profit child care organization, to provide front-end technical assistance to applicants to assist them in preparing to apply to operate a licensed child care program. The Department of Workforce Development (DWD) may provide a child care start-up and expansion grant, a child care staff retention grant or a child care quality improvement grant to an applying child care provider. Department information subject to disclosure under open records law includes the licensing of a day care center, including its address, the certification of a day care provider for reimbursement under the Wisconsin Shares child care subsidy program, the contracting for operation of a day care program and the provision of a grant to a child care provider.

Under Wisconsin law, most documentation regarding child care licensure is public record: the application, letter of transmittal and certificate, statements of noncompliances and corrective action plan, complaint information, and any enforcement documents. Certain documentation is confidential such as children's names, health records, and child abuse/neglect reports. DHFS licensing staff receive frequent contacts from the public and parents regarding the 5,000+ licensed Wisconsin child care programs (2,698 family day care programs serving 4-8 children; 2,285 group centers for 9 or more children and 72 day camps with an estimated capacity to serve over 180,000 children). Families ask for information about their child's day care center and compliance history and DHFS receives and investigates over 1600 complaints annually regarding child care programs.

DHFS provides the public information regarding licensed providers/facilities to state agencies such as the Department of Public Instruction for purposes of the U.S.D.A. Child and Adult Care Food Program, the Department of Workforce Development and the Department of Commerce; to county and tribal agencies or the agency with which it contracts for purposes of child care certification; to local municipalities for building inspections and fire safety related purposes. It also provides information to the seventeen Child Care Resource and Referral Agencies contracting with the state Department of Workforce Development to assist parents in locating and choosing quality child care and handling grants. The department further responds to public records requests for lists of licensed providers.

Current statute and rules for child care facilities require that records continue to be open and available for distribution to other agencies and individuals.

Therefore DHFS proposes that this bill include language that does not restrict the department's ability to release facility addresses upon request pursuant to current public records laws.

For example: A person applying for a family day care license or for continuation of a license to operate a day care center in the person's home may designate that the street address of the person not be disclosed on a list (directory) of licensed child care providers to any person except as necessary for administering the child care regulation and licensing program, certification program, or contract by a school board with a child care provider, and to a federal, state or local governmental agency or agency with which the governmental agency contracts for purposes of permitting the agency to perform a legally authorized function. The federal, state or local governmental agency or its contractee to which that information is disclosed may not further disclose the information to any person except for purposes of performing the legally authorized function(s) for which that information was disclosed to the agency.

Similar language could be added as follows:

A person applying for certification or recertification as a family day care provider who intends to provide day care in the person's home, a person proposing to contract or to renew a contract with a school board to provide a day care program in the person's home, a person applying for a child care start-up and expansion grant, a child care staff retention grant or a child care quality improvement grant who provides day care in the person's home may designate that the street address of the person may not be disclosed to any person except as necessary for administering the child care certification program, or contract by a school board with a child care provider, and to a federal, state or local governmental agency or its contractee for purposes of permitting the agency to perform a legally authorized function. The federal, state or local governmental agency or contractee to which that information is disclosed may not further disclose the information to any person except for purposes of performing the legally authorized functions for which that information was disclosed to the agency.

Please contact me regarding the Department of Health and Family Services' position that day care regulation not be restricted by the current language of this bill prohibiting the department's ability to provide open records information to other agencies in the performance of their duties and to individuals properly requesting information under open records law.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department of health and family services (DHFS) may license a person to operate a day care center, a county department of human services or social services (county department) may certify a day care provider for reimbursement under the Wisconsin works program, and a school board may contract for the provision of day care programs for children. In addition, the department of workforce development (DWD) may provide a child care start-up and expansion grant, a child care staff retention grant or a child care quality improvement grant to an applying child care provider. Currently, information obtained in the process of licensing a person to operate a day care center, certifying a day care provider for reimbursement under the Wisconsin works program, contracting with a person to provide a day care program and providing a grant to a child care provider is subject to disclosure under the open records law.

This bill permits a person applying to DHFS for a license, or for continuance of a license, to operate a day care center in the person's home, a person applying to a county department for certification or recertification as a day care provider who intends to provide day care in the person's home, a person proposing to contract or to renew a contract with a school board to provide a day care program in the person's

home and a person applying to DWD for a child care start-up and expansion grant, a child care staff retention grant ~~or~~ a child care quality improvement grant, who provides day care in the person's home to designate that the street address of the person may not be published in any list or directory of day care providers published by DHFS, DWD, the county department or the school board. If a person makes that designation, DHFS, DWD, the county department, or the school board may not publish the person's street address in any list or directory of day care providers published by DHFS, DWD, the county department or the school board.

The bill, however, specifically does not prohibit DHFS, DWD, a county department, or a school board from disclosing the person's street address to any person in response to that person's request under the open records law to inspect and copy the records of DHFS, DWD, the county department or the school board, to a federal, state or local governmental agency or a contractor of such an agency for purposes of permitting that agency or contractor to perform a legally authorized function or to any other person as necessary for DHFS or the county department to regulate and license or certify day care providers, for DWD to administer its grant programs or for the school board to provide day care programs for children. Under the bill, a federal, state or local governmental agency or contractor to which a person's street address is disclosed may not further disclose the street address to any person except for purposes of performing the legally authorized function for which the street address was disclosed to the agency or contractor.

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would prohibit the Department from publishing the address of any child care provider at their request who provides care in his/her home. This information would remain available through information requests made under the open records law.

The Department does not currently, nor does it intend to, publish any publicly available list of provider addresses. The Department does maintain records of provider addresses in its Child Care Payment System in order to mail subsidy payments to qualified providers. The information kept in this system is available to State and Local child care administrators.

There would be no fiscal impact to the Department upon passage of this bill.

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would allow an individual who is licensed by DHFS or who applies for a license to operate a day care center and who provides the day care services in his or her home to specify that the Department not publish the individual's street address in any list or directory of day care providers. The bill would not prohibit DHFS from providing the address under an open records request, or to other governmental agencies for legally authorized function, or as necessary to carry out licensing activities.

Under current law, DHFS licenses day care providers that care for four or more children under seven years old for compensation. The Department produces on a routine basis directories or other lists of providers and distributes them to other governmental agencies, such as the Department of Public Instruction, which oversees the federal Child and Adult Food Program, and county and tribes that certify child care providers. The Department provides the child care directory information to the Wisconsin Child Care Improvement Project, with which it contracts to provide technical assistance to child care license applicants. DHFS also shares this information with the 17 Child Care Resource and Referral Agencies, which are under contract with the Department of Workforce Development to serve providers and assist parents to find child care. The Department produces and distributes a public directory of child care providers to the public and to private organizations upon request.

The Department generates these lists from a computer database of licensed providers. The Department would have to modify this database in order to record which providers have requested that their names not be printed and to exclude those addresses when generating lists. It is estimated that the necessary system changes and software upgrades would cost \$16,000 GPR on a one time basis. The Department is not able to absorb these costs within its existing budget.
