Certification is based on such criteria as the number of new jobs the business is likely to create, the amount of capital investment that the business is likely to make in the state, and the likelihood that the business will attract related enterprises.

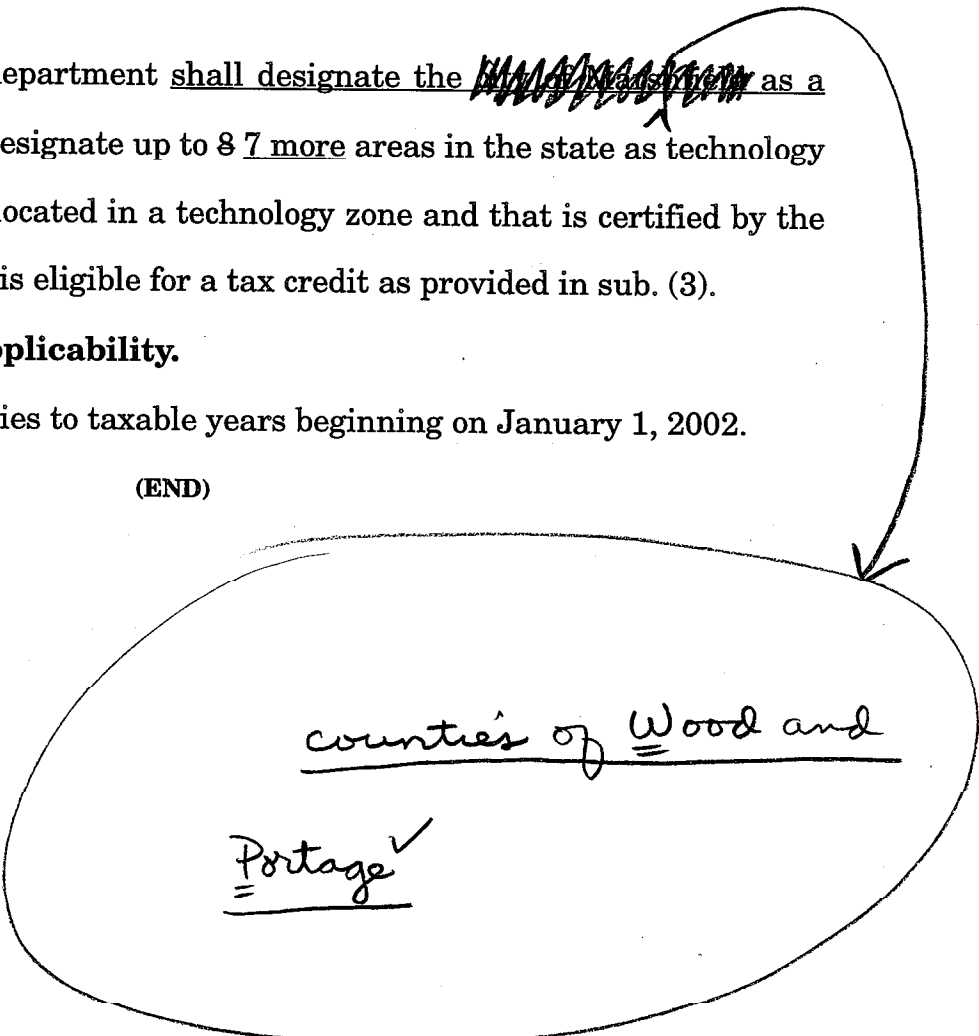
