 - 961.573 **(3)** No person may use, or possess with the primary intent to use, drug paraphernalia to manufacture, compound, convert, produce, process, prepare, test, analyze, pack, repack, or store methamphetamine or a controlled substance analog of methamphetamine in violation of this chapter. Any Subject to sub. **(4)**, any person who violates this subsection may be fined not more than \$10,000 or imprisoned for not more than 5 years or both.
