Telephone conference with Tanya Hein, 6-3520, in Rep. Skindrud's office. Wants substitute amendment to AB-665 drafted to allow reciprocity so that if another state allows a bus to pull a trailer, that bus could enter Wisconsin. Eliminate all requirements relating to emergency exits, etc. Draft should only cover buses from other states that enter Wisconsin. Intent is that if it is legal to pull a trailer behind a bus in another state, they can bring the bus and trailer into Wisconsin. Rep. Skindrud is working on this with Rep. Pettis. This is needed before they exec on Jan. 8.

1 AN ACT to amend 346.94 (15) of the statutes; relating to: allowing certain school
2 buses to tow trailers.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, no person may operate a school bus with a trailer or semitrailer attached. This bill allows the operation of a school bus with a trailer or semitrailer attached if the school bus is equipped with a side emergency exit door or side emergency exit windows.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 346.94 (15) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 346.94 (15) TOWING BY BUSES OR HUMAN SERVICE VEHICLES. No person may
5 operate a school bus or a human service vehicle over any public highway of this state
6 with any trailer or semitrailer attached. This subsection does not apply to a school

7 bus ~~equipped with a side emergency exit door or side emergency exit windows.~~
