## DRAFTER'S NOTE FROM THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU

November 28, 2001

Under current law, if the motor vehicle operating privilege of a person holding a commercial driver license is suspended or revoked for operating a noncommercial motor vehicle while intoxicated, the person may apply for an occupational license to operate commercial motor vehicles. Under this bill, if a person's operating privilege is revoked for operating a sport recreational vehicle while intoxicated, the person may not operate sport recreational vehicles *or* commercial motorboats during the revocation period. Do you want to exclude operating a sport recreational vehicle while intoxicated? And exclude operating privilege revocation for sport recreational vehicles in those cases involving operating a commercial motorboat while intoxicated.
