## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Current law requires that every boat must have a personal flotation device for each person riding in the boat. This bill requires that any person 16 years or younger riding in a boat less than 26 feet in length must wear a personal flotation device while the boat is being operated unless the person is in a cabin space or below the deck.

No significiant impact is expected upon court operations. Additional revenue could result for the state and county from the forfeiture penalties but this amount is impossible to predict since the number of violaltions that will occur is unknown.
