Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires physicians to provide certain information when issuing prescription orders to treat children with attention deficit hyperactivity disorder. The bill also requires the Department of Health and Family Services to prepare informational materials on certain controlled substances and requires the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) to disseminate these informational materials to appropriate public school staff.

It is assumed that one packet of informational materials will be sent to each of Wisconsin's 426 school districts. Depending on the volume of the informational materials that the DPI is required to disseminate, postage costs are expected to be between \$100 and \$300. There may be additional costs associated with staff time to assemble the required informational materials. These costs are expected to be absorbed within the agency's operating budget.
