## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill could either increase or decrease SPD costs, depending upon the net effect on the number of prosecutions for carrying a concealed weapon (a decrease in cases would decrease costs; an increase in cases would increase costs). Another variable is the possibility that the SPD might get more requests for postconviction representation to challenge previous convictions (in order to meet the licensing criteria).

The counties could incur costs for the sheriff's review of license applications and maintaining license records.
