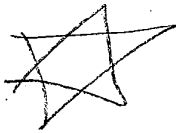
Can you call me when you get a chance to talk about how the bill should treat pending cases? One provision (beginning at 23/13) says that the sheriff has to **suspend** a person's license if the person is charged with a crime that would require revocation if the person were convicted. But sub. (14) (a) and (3) (o), in combination, would require **revocation** once the person is charged (or if the person becomes the subject of any proceeding -- civil or criminal -- that could result in disqualifying the person).

I think you wanted only to require suspension. That can be fixed with a fairly simple amendment. The only question is whether you want the suspension provision to apply to pending civil cases (like mental health commitment proceedings).

Given the complexity of the bill and all of the changes that we made, it was probably inevitable that there would be a couple of glitches; but I'm still sorry about this. ↖ yes

FYI -- drafting the memo comparing the bills is what led me to find this.
