January 4, 2002 – Introduced by Representatives Pettis, Ladwig, Musser, Ainsworth, McCormick, Ryba, Krawczyk, Staskunas and Townsend, cosponsored by Senators Moen and Welch. Referred to Committee on Education.

1 AN ACT *to create* 118.33 (1) (e) of the statutes; **relating to:** granting high school 2 credit for extracurricular sports.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires a high school student to earn 1.5 credits in physical education in order to be eligible for a high school diploma. This bill authorizes a school board to grant a pupil credit in physical education for participating in an extracurricular sport if the sport is watched by a person who is licensed to teach physical education.

## *The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 118.33 (1) (e) of the statutes is created to read:
118.33 (1) (e) A school board may grant a pupil credit in physical education
under par. (a) 1. for participating in an extracurricular sport if the sport is watched
by a person who is licensed to teach physical education.
SECTION 2. Initial applicability.
