Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill expands the definition of peeping tom offenses and requires a person convicted or adjudicated to register with Wisconsin's Sex Offender Registry. This bill also allows a juvenile adjudicated under these statutes to expunge their record, under certain conditions, as well as requiring the Department of Corrections to remove the information from the Sex Offender Registry.

The Department cannot predict how many additional offenders will be required to register with the Sex Offender Registry, nor how many juvenile records will be removed. Nevertheless, the Department anticipates it can absorb any additional record keeping costs associated with this bill. Because this bill maintains a penalty for this offense that is under one year, state prison populations should not be affected. However, local jail populations could increase by an indeterminate amount due to the expanded definition.
