



Under current law, for snowmobiles that are required to be registered and for which an application for registration is pending with DNR, the operator is allowed to operate the snowmobile without the decals if the operator carries the receipt issued upon submittal of the registration application. Under the bill, for the operator of a snowmobile that is not yet registered and for which no registration receipt has yet been issued by DNR, the operator must carry the original or a copy of the assigned registration certificate that was delivered to the owner on the date of sale. This exemption from displaying the decals is valid for 60 days after the date of sale.

Insert analysis

Under current law, with limited exceptions, no person may operate a snowmobile unless it is registered with the department of natural resources (DNR), the person carries the registration certificate, and the registration decals issued by DNR are displayed on the snowmobile. Under current law, a person may operate a snowmobile for which an application for registration is pending with DNR without having the decals displayed on the snowmobile if the person carries the receipt issued upon submittal of the registration application.

Under the bill, a person may operate a snowmobile for which a neither a registration receipt nor a registration certificate has been issued to the current owner without having the decals displayed on the snowmobile if the person carries the original or a copy of registration certificate delivered to the current owner upon transfer of ownership. This exemption from displaying the decals is valid for 45 days after the date of transfer of ownership.
