Under current law, with limited exceptions, no person may operate a snowmobile unless it is registered with the department of natural resources (DNR), the person carries the registration certificate, and the registration decals issued by DNR are displayed on the snowmobile. Under current law, a person may operate a snowmobile for which an application for registration is pending with DNR without having the decals displayed on the snowmobile if the person carries the receipt issued upon submittal of the registration application.

Under the bill, a person may operate a snowmobile for which ^{the} neither a registration receipt nor a registration certificate has been issued to the current owner without having the decals displayed on the snowmobile if the person carries the original or a copy of registration certificate delivered to the current owner upon transfer of ownership.
