## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

THE PERSON IN

This bill permits a court in OWI cases to withhold sentencing the person until it has reviewed the person's compliance with the alcohol assessment. It also provides that if a court orders a person to comply with an assessment and driver safety plan and the person has one or no prior OWI related conviction, the court may order that no occupational license be issued until the person has completed the assessment and driver safety plan.

These additional sentencing alternatives are not expected to increase the operating costs of the circuit courts.
