Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

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This proposal allows courts to withhold sentencing and deny occupational license for OWI offenders until they have complied with the AODA assessment and are complying with their driver safety plan.

While this proposal changes the order in which sentencing, assessment and driver safety plan compliance may take place, it does not increase or decrease the workload. We anticipate very little impact on occupational licenses because many courts no longer require first offenders to appear for 1st offense OWI and multiple offenders are already subject to waiting periods for occupational licenses.

There is a one-time cost of approximately \$2,000 to replace 3-ply DMV assessment referral form MV3632 with a 4 ply version to give courts a mechanism to communicate to WisDOT. This represents the cost of restocking 30,000 forms at a cost of \$65.48 per 1,000.
