A class A bear license and a class B bear license are different licenses and different approvals and thus the below proposal would not violate the above statutory prohibition, in my opinion.

I cannot find any place in the statutes or in the administrative code that states that a person who is issued a Class A bear hunting license may not also be issued a Class B bear hunting license for the same season. Concerning the necessity of drafting language stating that the transferor of the Class A license may get a Class B license, I have spoken to Bill Mytton who spoke to DNR Attorney Tim Andryk. Although s. 29.024 (2) (c) says a person may not be issued the same license for the same season, Class A and Class B licenses are different licenses. Both Tim and I agree, therefore, that no additional language is needed.
