Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Because appropriate providers of runaway services are exempted under this bill, we believe that this bill will not have a fiscal effect on local or state governments. Missing children reports currently cause some level of investigation and this proposal would provide another prosecution tool. In some cases, the investigations may actually be reduced because the appropriate individuals have notified law enforcement agencies in order to comply with this proposal.
