

2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 783

February 7, 2002 – Introduced by Representatives ZIEGELBAUER, NASS, ALBERS, BIES, CARPENTER, COLON, GROTHMAN, HAHN, HINES, HUNDERTMARK, JESKEWITZ, KESTELL, KREIBICH, F. 1 **AN ACT relating to:** salaries paid to the governor, state senators, and
2 representatives to the assembly during the 2003–04 legislature.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill provides that the governor is to receive an annual salary of \$122,406 during the 2003–04 legislature and that each state senator and representative to the assembly is to receive an annual salary of \$44,233 during the 2003–04 legislature. If this bill is not enacted, the governor will be paid an annual salary of \$131,768 during the 2003–04 legislature and each state senator and representative to the assembly will be paid an annual salary of \$45,569 during the 2003–04 legislature.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

6 relating to establishing the annual salary of each state senator and each
7 representative to the assembly during the 2001–03 fiscal biennium, during the
8 2003–04 legislature, the annual salary of each state senator and each representative
9 to the assembly shall be \$44,233.
