CHANGE 10 YEAR TIME FRAME IN COUNTY FOREST PLANS TO 15 YEARS

Reasoning: Time savings for both DNR and County. General feeling is that 10 years is such a short time frame that you no sooner finish one cycle and you're almost ready to start the process again. We don't want the process and the planning efforts to overshadow the actual work (e.g. USFS).

Statute: 28.11(5)(a)

Suggested Change: A comprehensive county forest land use plan shall be prepared for a 15-year period by §§§§. The application will be considered an annual application for these aids during the 15-year period of the plan.

CHANGE AD SIZE ON TIMBER SALES FROM CLASSIFIED TO DISPLAY AD SIZES

Reasoning: Improve visibility of sale ads. Display ads are better than classified ads and bordered to draw more attention to potential bidders.

Statute: 28.11(6)(b) although to be consistent it would be wise to change 28.05(9) as well.

Suggested Change: Any timber sale with a value of \$1000 or more shall be by sealed bid or public sale after publication of a classified or display-sized advertisement announcing the sale in §§§.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, for each county forest, the department of natural resources (DNR) and the county board of the county in which the county forest is located must approve a comprehensive land use plan for the county forest. The county forestry committee prepares the plan. Under current law, the effective period for the plan is 10 years. This bill increases the effective period of the plan to 15 years.

For further information see the ***state and local*** fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 28.11 (5) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 28.11 (5) (a) A comprehensive county forest land use plan shall be prepared for
5 a ~~10-year~~ 15-year period by the county forestry committee with the assistance of
6 technical personnel from the department and other interested agencies, and shall be
7 approved by the county board and the department. The plan shall include land use

1 designations, land acquisition, forest protection, annual allowable timber harvests,
