Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would authorize any municipality to issue temporary Class "B" and "Class B" licenses to caterers that hold a restaurant permit, prepare and transport food for consumption, and receive more than 50% of total gross receipts of food and beverage sales from the sale of food. The bill would also permit an owner, lessee, or person in charge of a public place to allow the consumption of beer and intoxicating liquor on the premises provided by a caterer holding the appropriate temporary license. Finally, the bill would also allow beer to be served by a caterer holding a temporary license at a catered event on premises where other business is conducted.

The bill is expected to have no effect on state tax revenues, or on the cost of state or local alcohol regulation.
