Mary and Robin:

The Joint Committee for Review of Administrative Rules has again objected, in part, to a rule promulgated by the Department of Natural Resources. The rule is Clearinghouse Rule 00-154, relating to deer hunting and the wildlife damage abatement and claims program.

The Assembly Committee on Natural Resources objected to parts of CHR 00-154 on November 7, 2001. On January 10, 2002, JCRAR made similar objections with respect to two portions of the rule. The pertinent actions follow:

1. Part of the proposed rule states that, when a Zone T deer hunt is required, one of the modifications to the deer season must consist of "A 4-day anterless only deer season allowing the use of bows and guns starting on the Thursday nearest October 22." [See s. NR 10.01(3)(ez).]

The Assembly Committee exercised its objection powers to restate the above-quoted language to read: "A 4-day anterless only deer season allowing the use of bows and guns in October."

JCRAR took the same action under s. 227.19(5)(d), Stats.

Consequently, the bills to sustain the January 11, 2002 action of JCRAR should include a provision along the following lines: "The department may not promulgate a rule establishing an October deer herd control hunt when the hunt is required to begin on the Thursday nearest October 22."
