Representative Ladwig:

Some municipalities straddle county lines. In those cases, it is possible that a polling place may serve an area that straddles a county line as well. This amendment accounts for that contingency by providing that, if a polling place serves more than one county, an inspector who preforms duties at that polling place must be a qualified elector of one of the counties served by the polling place. The amendment also removes a sentence from s. 7.30 (2) (b), stats., that is rendered unnecessary by the bill and the amendment.
