Effect of amendment is to remove 15 year-old-minors from coverage under the bill. Without this amendment, any 15 year old minor employed by an election board would be in violation of the Federal law, if alhe were to work more than 3 hours, even if those hours were worked during non-school hours.

Amend Assembly Bill 826 on page 1, line 6, after 11.21 (14) add 4, 103.68 (1)*

On page 22 line 5 add the following words: Section 35, 103.68 (1):

delete the period at the end of the first full sentence of 103.68 (1) and insert.", except that minors aged 16 and 17 when employed by a municipality as poll workers, are exempt from the hours of work and time of day restrictions during the duration of their term as poll workers."


