## DRAFTER'S NOTE FROM THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU

Chapter 341 provides certain registration exceptions for specified special interest vehicles, driver education vehicles, and reconstructed, replica, street modified, and homemade vehicles. Concomitant with the registration exceptions for these vehicles are use limitations on the vehicles. If the vehicle is operated on a highway in violation of the use limitations without being registered under the general registration statute, the operator may be required to forfeit not more than \$200. See ss. 341.266 (2) (e) 3. and (5), 341.267 (1r), and 341.268 (2) (e) 3. and (5). Do you want to also amend these penalty provisions to include a minimum forfeiture of \$100, since these provisions in effect penalize operation of the specified vehicles without proper registration?

There is also a similar forfeiture (not more than \$200) for operation of a vehicle for which no certificate of title has been issued or applied for. See s. 342.05 (4). Do you also want to amend this provision to include a minimum forfeiture of \$100?
