Statutory Revisions - Continuing Education

The board has asked that legislation be created authorizing the board to require that licensees complete continuing education during each bicnnial licensure period. One approach would be as follows:

### AMMEND SEC. 453.03(2), STATS., AS FOLLOWS:

**453.03 Rules.** (1) The examining board shall promulgate rules, within the limits of the definition under s. 453.02(6), establishing the scope of practice permitted for veterinarians and veterinary technicians and shall review the rules at least once every 5 years to determine whether they are consistent with current practice. The examining board may promulgate rules relating to licensure qualifications, denial of a license, certificate or temporary permit, unprofessional conduct and disciplinary proceedings.

(2) The examining board shall promulgate rules requiring training and continuing education sufficient to assure competency of veterinarians and veterinary technicians in <u>areas relevant to current veterinary practice</u>, including rules relating to the use, handling, distribution and disposal of pesticides.

#### CREATE SEC. 453.062, STATS., TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

**453.062 Biennial training requirement.** (1) Each veterinarian shall, at the time of application for renewal of the license, submit proof of attendance at and completion of continuing education programs or courses of study approved for at least 30 hours of credit by the board within the 2 years preceding the renewal date.

- (2) Each veterinary technician shall, at the time of application for renewal of the certificate, submit proof of attendance at and completion of continuing education programs of courses of study approved for at least 15 hours of credit by the board within the 2-years preceding the renewal date.
- (3) The board may waive the continuing education requirement if it finds that exceptional circumstances such as prolonged illness, disability or other similar circumstances have prevented a veterinarian or a veterinary technician from meeting the requirement.

- (4) During the time between initial licensure and commencement of a full 2-year licensure or certification period, new licensees shall not be required to meet continuing education requirements.
- (5) The board may at any time require a veterinarian or veterinary technician to submit proof of continuing education programs or courses of study that he or she has attended and completed during the preceding full 2-year licensure or certification period.
