Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This will have impacts on several areas of the department, as do other existing CE requirements:

Legal services will do the rules.

Renewal will have to check the CE completion signatures on 4000 renewals every two years, and send back those that don't sign.

Bureaus will have to send out special notices to those that don't comply, and deny renewals of licenses to the noncompliant.

DOE may have to investigate CE along with other complaint investigation.

Education Office may have to establish a data base of approved courses, and may have to audit compliance periodically, depending on the rules established by the Board.

It is estimated the a .25 FTE Compliance Monitor and a .5 FTE Program Assistant 3 would be reqired.
